

Kevin was a little boy, nine years old. A \*railroad \*passed near his home. Kevin was always interested in the trains when they \*went running by. He liked to hear the train \*whistle. The whistle told him a train was coming.

(5) February twelfth was Kevin's birthday, and his grandmother was going to visit his home to give him a birthday present. She lived in the next town and usually came to his home by bus. But that day was Sunday and there was no \*bus service. So she was going to come by train that day. (1) Kevin liked his grandmother so much that he couldn't wait for her at his house and went to the station to meet her. But there was much time before the train arrived. So he went out of the station and began to walk along the \*track. There was a railroad bridge near the station. When Kevin was walking on the bridge, he ①(find) that one of the \*rails was \*broken. \*Just as Kevin saw that broken rail, he heard the whistle of the afternoon train. He thought, "I have to stop the train. If the train does not stop, it will \*jump off the track and fall down into the river! I must do something to help \*Grandma and people on the train."

Soon Kevin knew what he should do. He ran up the track to a \*curve. \*Beyond that curve there was a long \*straight part of the track. His grandmother's train \*was approaching toward him fast. Then he \*took off his jacket and his hat, and stood in the \*middle of the track. He \*waved them very hard. He thought, "Will the \*engineer see me and stop the train before it gets to the broken rail?" \*Luckily the engineer saw him, and \*blew the whistle to tell Kevin to \*get away from the track. But Kevin did not move at all. So the engineer blew the whistle again. Still he did not move. Then the engineer thought that something was wrong, and stopped the train in front of Kevin.
